Hope International University in Fullerton, CA is now accepting applications for a full-time Counseling/Clinical Psychology faculty position at the level of Professor, Associate Professor, or Assistant Professor. The position will remain open until filled.

Responsibilities include teaching courses in the areas of social and behavioral sciences, psychology, marriage and family therapy, and human development. The candidate will be expected to mentor undergraduate and/or graduate students, share in student advising and actively participate in the department and University. Position will include both undergraduate and graduate teaching load.

Candidates must have a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Counseling/Clinical Psychology from a regionally accredited program. Evidence of strong clinical supervision skills and significant clinical experience is required. Courses taught will require experience in clinical skills, assessment, family systems, and therapy techniques. Must be Board of Psychology licensed or license eligible.

Desired Qualifications

Evidence of effective teaching in higher education, as well as a commitment to excellence in teaching, general education and student-centered research programs is desired. Experience supervising doctoral level research and an emphasis in Neuropsychology are highly desirable.
