**College 101 – Parent's Orientation:** While the students meet with their Barnabas Groups hear from the President and meet some of our faculty, staff, and administrators. We will have raffles and gifts we have selected just for you.

**Celebration:** We want to come together to celebrate in worship, welcoming our new students and families while asking God to bless the coming semester. This time serves as the parents' closing session and we ask that you help us to better serve our community by filling out the parent survey.

**Basketball Games:** Although the family portion of NSO has concluded we encourage everyone to make time to cheer on our women's and men's basketball teams. Directions to the game can be found with assistance from the Information Desk Assistants in the lobby of the Student Center.
